

613th AOC synchronizes first USAF, RAAF nonstop C2 mission from Alaska to Australia

JOINT BASE PEARL HARBOR-HICKAM, Hawaii -- Airmen from the 613th Air Operations Center here were the nerve center for the movement of seven C-17 Globemasters carrying almost 450 U.S. Army paratroopers on a nonstop flight from Joint Base Elmendorf-Richardson, Alaska, to Royal Australian Air Force Base Amberley, Australia, July 8.

The 613th AOC provided this 22-hour command and control capability, which included two Royal Australian Air Force C-17s from the 36th Airlift Squadron, four C-17s from Air Mobility Command and one C-17 from Pacific Air Forces. The training across two hemispheres was completed in one day, as part of Talisman Sabre 15.

"There were many moving parts involved with launching these aircraft and getting them to Australia in a secure manner, and more than a thousand people were involved in successfully completing this operation," said Maj. Kaialii Kahele, the 613th AOC Air Mobility Division airlift control team chief. "This was the kick-off to Talisman Sabre, the largest (U.S.) Pacific Command exercise, and it was successfully completed as a joint, coalition effort that demonstrated our global reach and global power."

To allow for a nonstop flight, four KC-10 Extenders from Travis Air Force Base, California, and three KC-10s from Joint Base McGuire-Dix-Lakehurst, New Jersey, created an air bridge in the skies above the Pacific, delivering 804,000 pounds of fuel.

"The refueling piece happened in 35 minutes with no issues," Kahele said. "This coordination displayed our unity of effort and it demonstrates how we can reach anywhere around PACAF -- 52 percent of the world's surface -- at any time." Before the aircraft touched down at RAAF

Amberley, Soldiers with the 4th Brigade Combat Team, 25th Infantry Division from Fort Richardson, Alaska, parachuted onto Kapyong Air Field, Queensland, Australia.

"The air drop commenced precisely in the five minute window," Kahele said. "This demonstrated the strategic airpower of the U.S. and Australian Air Forces with our coalition partners. At the time of the jump, I looked at my watch and knew that somewhere over Australia the 4th Brigade is jumping out of U.S. and Australian C-17s. I had a part in that, and it almost felt like I was there."

Airmen and their Australian counterparts also worked the command and control piece together, where they stayed in constant contact with the C-17 and pilots and were ready for any

unplanned contingencies, like changes in weather or aircraft issues.

"I have been associated with numerous Talisman Sabre exercises and the (Air Force) integration with the RAAF is not only vastly improved over the years, but it is relatively seamless at this point and a critical enabler for contingency operations in the Pacific," said Col. David Moeller, the 613th AOC commander.

About 30,000 U.S. and Australian personnel will participate in the exercise throughout the Pacific region stretching from the California coast to Australia. Talisman Sabre, which will run through July 19, is a jointly sponsored exercise by the U.S. Pacific Command and Australian Defense Force Headquarters Joint Operations Command.

Creating lethal weapons

Shooting, reloading and taking apart weapons are common skillsets learned in the 509th Security Forces Squadron. However, building personal weapons is a skill mastered by very few defenders.

Senior Airman Nicholas Fralick, 509th SFS member, has had a passion for weapons since childhood but it evolved at Lackland Air Force Base, Texas, where he first fired a

weapon during basic military training.

"I've always imagined owning my own weapon since my younger days," Fralick said. "I never had a chance to fire a weapon until BMT. It was then that my passion for weapons began to increase and magnify."

Fralick's increased passion influenced his decision to build AR-15 assault rifles.

"I wanted an AR-15 for a long time and since a regular store bought one didn't have specific features I wanted, I decided to build one," Fralick said. "I purchased multiple

parts and watched YouTube videos to learn how to put them together. I developed a desire for constructing weapons after putting together my first assault rifle."

Fralick orders parts online, one piece at a time, and puts them together at home. He can build a weapon in 2-3 hours once he has all the parts on hand.

"Parts can be expensive depending on the quality," Fralick said. "For instance, a person will spend a lot of money buying





optics that are name-brand. Optics can be very expensive on the market, but I've used knock offs and they worked well."

Fralick constantly researches different ways and techniques to construct his weapons.

"After I build the weapon, I'm never satisfied with the finishing product," Fralick said. "I'm always tweaking and coming up with different features to add onto my weapons whether it's a new scope, extended barrel or paint."

Fralick also shoots his weapons when he goes to the range to ensure his products function properly. If there are any defects, he repairs them goes back out to fire them again. When the weapons work properly, he is content resumes researching new ways and features.

Fralick treasures his weapons and does not promote selling them.

"I sold one weapon and I still regret it," Fralick said. It was a 9 mm Glock 19 handgun, the first weapon I ever bought, and I sold it because I was getting another 9 mm handgun. I sold for 500 which was the price of the new weapon, but my heart was still with my first handgun."

Fralick's special talent left a remarkable impression on his supervisor.

"Fralick enjoys the casual conversations about weapons with personnel as he checks their weapon for their monthly inspections," said Staff Sgt. Steven Romero, 509th SFS assistant NCO in charge of armory. "Building something with your own hands always gives people great satisfaction. Building something that should always be respected and giving the proper safety procedures such as for a weapon is a class on its own that very few have come to know, but Fralick's ability is among those few."

Fralick's passion for weapons mirrors his career in the Air Force.

"Being Security Forces allows me to get a lot of hands on action with the weapons," Fralick said. "In tech school, we were allowed to fire different variety of weapons and that also fueled my interested to start making my own weapons."
