

U.S. AIR FORCE VICTIMS' COUNSEL (VC)

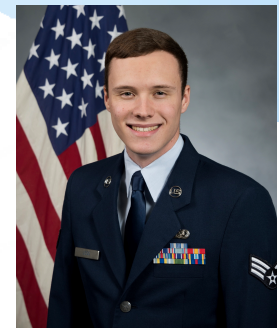

 - PROTECTS YOUR RIGHTS & PRIVACY INTERESTS
 - PROVIDES LEGAL ASSISTANCE
 - ADVISES YOU ON THE INVESTIGATION & PROSECUTION PROCESSES
 - ATTENDS INTERVIEWS WITH YOU
 - ATTENDS HEARINGS & COURTS-MARTIAL WITH YOU
- **WHO DOES THE VC WORK FOR? YOU!**
 - VC **DOES NOT** WORK FOR ANYONE ON YOUR BASE
 - CHAIN OF COMMAND IS AN INDEPENDENT OFFICE IN D.C.
