SUBJECT: Whiteman AFB Environmental Management System (EMS) Policy

1. At Whiteman AFB, sustainability is one of our highest priorities and is accomplished by protecting the environment, people, and mission. We are dedicated to continual improvement of our processes and methodologies that reduce waste, promote pollution prevention, and enhance safety while fulfilling our mission requirements to *execute Strategic Nuclear Operations, Lethal Global Strike, and Combat Support.* Environmental concerns for our region/local area include maintaining air quality, protecting Missouri's natural resources, and managing waste materials in a manner that reduces land disposal burden. Progress on these objectives and targets will be reviewed and briefed to the Environmental, Safety, and Occupational Health Council at least annually. To achieve sustainability and compatibility, we will continue to meet all applicable environmental laws, regulations and *AFI 32-7001 Environmental Management 23 August 2019.* In all of our activities we will strive to:

a. Integrate environmental information into all levels of management to facilitate environmental awareness in all decision-making processes.

b. Promote conservation and sustainable use of natural and manmade materials.

c. Minimize environmental pollution and waste.

d. Factor regional/local environmental concerns (such as hazardous waste, and water quality) into all policies, programs, and missions.

e. Achieve continuous improvements in environmental performance over and above regulatory and legislative requirements.

f. Partner with all stakeholders and share information on environmental performance with the public, when requested.

g. Establish and review environmental objectives and targets by considering significant environmental aspects and other factors important to the base.

2. This environmental policy applies to all members of the 509th Bomb Wing, contractors, and associated tenants. This policy shall be communicated to all employees and made available to the public. Environmental stewardship is the responsibility of every member of Team Whiteman in accordance with their roles and responsibilities in the organization.
