The purpose of this Economic Impact Report is to present Whiteman Air Force Base's impact on the local economy during Fiscal Year 2021. 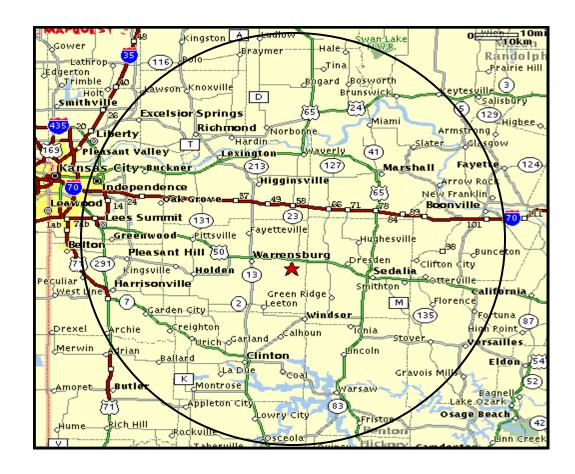

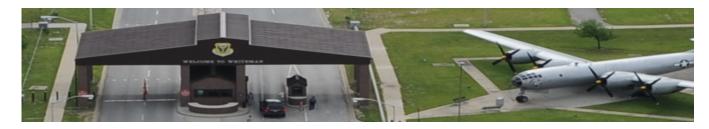
