

The 131st gains two new resources to help Airmen face life challenges

Dana Livsey, 131st Bomb Wing's director of psychological health, and Ivory Jamerson, 131st Bomb Wing family readiness coordinator, recently joined the wing in support of its Citizen-Airmen and their families.

Livsey and Jamerson each run a program that complements the other's well, and said they are already working closely to build a strong Airmen and family support system.

Dana Livsey is a native to Saline County, Missouri, near the Marshall area, and has been with the wing since August. By living near Whiteman, she became familiar with the location, which sparked an interest in providing psychological help services to the servicemembers on base. Livsey previously worked for the 509th Mental Health Flight for 11 years as a social worker.

"As the director of psychological health I offer brief consultation or more in-depth problem-solving for emotional or interpersonal relationship difficulties or day-to-day difficulties the members or their families may encounter," Livsey said.

The DPH works to understand the needs of members or their families, then offers resources and referrals to get them connected with resources in their communities. Different workshops are also available on topics like stress management, coping with loss and parenting skills. Members and families can also receive counseling on how to emotionally prepare for deployment, as well as how to reintegrate back into the relationship afterwards.

"When Col. (Kenneth) Eaves (131st Bomb Wing vice commander) explained the job to me, he said it was basically a one-stop psychological health shop," Livsey said. "Whether it's finding the resources someone needs to help them out, or providing them myself, we provide the extra support that can be really helpful to get a service member through a tough situation or a tough time in their life." She added that her services are free, confidential and easy to access, and don't

rely on insurance coverage.

Ivory Jamerson originally hails from Los Angeles, California, but has since settled down in Warrensburg, Missouri. She has worked in family services as a civilian since 2007, when she accompanied her active duty Airman husband to Kadena Air Base in Okinawa, Japan. More recently, she worked in an Army Family Assistance Center before joining the 131st Force Support Squadron in her current role in October.

Her husband's military service kept Jamerson close to the military – he's now a Guardsman in the wing – and she said she understands firsthand the importance of taking care of the member and their family.

The Family Readiness Program consists of three major parts, according to Jamerson: Yellow Ribbon; Strong Bonds, which is a chaplainoperated program; and Key Spouses and Key Volunteers.

"Through this network and team we provide education services for the member's families



Q. What are your personal goals?



Q. What are your thoughts about carrying out the bomber egacy?



Tax time assistance

It's that time of the year again - time to file income taxes. To help members of Team Whiteman efficiently and effectively get their taxes filed, the base tax office officially opened Feb. 1 and will run through April 15. Service is available to all Active Duty, Guard and Reserve personnel, as well as DoD civilian employees, dependents and retirees.

The first week, Feb. 1 to 5, will be dedicated to processing simple returns only (single income source, no itemized deductions) on a walk-in basis.

Starting Feb. 8, the tax office will begin processing tax returns for individuals whose gross income is under \$150,000; with no substantial rental properties or business income; and no bankruptcies, foreclosures or other types of cancellation of debt, as these issues exceed the expertise of this volunteer program. Walk-ins for simple filers will then be every Friday from 8:15 to 11:15 a.m. and 1 to 3:15 p.m. All others will need to make an appointment. From Feb. 9 to 11, the tax center will be closed, but will resume operation on Feb. 13.

What is needed for tax returns:

- 1. Copy of all tax paperwork (W-2s, 1098's, 1099's, etc.)
- 2. Social Security cards for all individuals on tax return
- 3. Account number and routing number for tax return
 - 4. Copy of last year tax return, if available
- 5. If you used the Whiteman Tax Center last year, your data is stored except for your bank information.

**Additional tax assistance is also available through Military OneSource. Consultants can assist via toll-free telephone between 7 a.m. and 11 p.m. (EST) through April 15. For more information, visit militaryonesource.com.

and dependents, information on how to connect to the military and their members and how to be a support," she said.

The program also offers newcomers' orientations designed to welcome the member's family to the Guard family, and how to best support the Guard. Additionally, it offers casualty affairs support when needed, and also connects members to different organizations that could help financially or

In short, "Family Readiness provides the leg work required to connect members and their families to resources they may need so members are free to focus on their jobs,"

Other resources include assisting members and dependents find employment, helping them with getting into a school, finding childcare and helping to smooth moves when families transition from one unit to another. There are also personal financial counselors who come out and are specifically trained to assist in personal finances when it comes to the military.

"The Family Readiness helps build strong families and strong communities that support our Airmen," Jamerson said. "We want Airmen to know that we're here for them, not just the family. We are the one-stop resource center.'




